The 8 pioneering individuals are Munshi Abdullah, Henry Nicholas Ridley, Tan Kah Kee, P. Govindasamy Pillai, Teresa Hsu Chih, Alice Pennefather, Adnan Saidi and Ruth Wong Hie King. <li data-bbox="506 616 1166 788">3. Below the portraits of the 8 pioneering individuals is an old Singapore River scene, which transits to the present-day Singapore River scene at the left of the note, to showcase Singapore’s transformation from a trading port into a business and financial hub. <li data-bbox="506 807 1166 946">4.
