# COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 34) NOTIFICATION 2015

#### ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

#### Citation

**1.** This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 34) Notification 2015.

# **Exemption**

- **2.**—(1) The Minister exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "Pick 11 Competition" promotion and the 11 draws to be held on 12 July 2015 from 12 noon to 7 p.m. at the Marquee of the Singapore Racecourse.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

## THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

#### **CONDITIONS**

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Only persons in the employment of the Singapore Turf Club may conduct a draw.
- 3. Every draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 4. Every draw must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 5. All winners must be notified by telephone or text message.
- 6. The Singapore Turf Club must, before the start of the draws, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draws are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 13 October 2015.
