In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles) (Exemption from Certain Part I Provisions) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 14 August 2017.

**Exemption**

2. Sections 10A, 11, 11AA, 11A, 13, 19, 28, 28A and 29 of the Act do not apply in respect of a power-assisted bicycle that —

- (a) is registered under the Road Traffic (Registration of Power-Assisted Bicycles) Rules 2017 (G.N. No. S 451/2017), or is kept or used without registration under rule 12 of those Rules;
- (b) complies with the requirements specified in the Schedule to the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles — Approval) Rules 2004 (G.N. No. S 768/2004); and

(c) is approved and sealed in accordance with the Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles — Approval) Rules 2004.

**Revocation**

3. The Road Traffic (Power-Assisted Bicycles) (Exemption from Part I and Section 91) Order 2004 (G.N. No. S 769/2004) is revoked.
