### **WORK INJURY COMPENSATION ACT 2019**

#### **WORK INJURY COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2023**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 82 of the Work Injury Compensation Act 2019, the Minister for Manpower makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.**—(1) These Regulations are the Work Injury Compensation (Amendment) Regulations 2023 and, except for regulation 4, come into operation on 30 June 2023.

(2) Regulation 4 is deemed to have come into operation on 31 December 2021.

#### **Amendment of regulation 2**

**2.** In the Work Injury Compensation Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 729/2020) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations), in regulation 2 —

(a) renumber the regulation as paragraph (1) of that regulation;  
and

(b) after paragraph (1), insert —

“(2) To avoid doubt, the reference to any hospital, clinic, healthcare establishment or other medical institution in paragraph (1) includes a reference to a person who holds a licence under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 to provide a licensable healthcare service.

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(3) In paragraph (2) and the First Schedule, “licensable healthcare service” has the meaning given by section 3(1) of the Healthcare Services Act 2020.”.

### **Amendment of First Schedule**

#### **3. In the principal Regulations, in the First Schedule —**

(a) replace the Schedule reference with —

“Regulation 2(1) and (3)”; and

(b) replace item 1 with —

“1. Any person who holds a licence under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 to provide any of the following licensable healthcare services:

(a) acute hospital service

(b) community hospital service

1A. Any nursing home licensed under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act 1980”.

### **Miscellaneous amendments**

#### **4. In the principal Regulations —**

(a) in regulation 3(4), replace “(Cap. 354A, Rg 3)” with “(Rg 3)”; and

(b) in regulation 13, replace “(Cap. 97)” with “1893”; and

(c) in regulation 27(1)(a), replace “(Cap. 1)” with “1965”.
