CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE

PUBLIC SERVICE (SPECIAL AND SENIOR PERSONNEL BOARDS) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 110D (1) and (2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the President, on the advice of the Prime Minister, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Public Service (Special and Senior Personnel Boards) (Amendment No. 3) Order 1999 and shall, with the exception of paragraph 2 (c), come into operation on 1st November 1999.

(2) Paragraph 2 (c) of this Order shall come into operation on 1st January 2000.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Public Service (Special and Senior Personnel Boards) Order (O 2, 1999 Ed.) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after the name “Mr Eddie Teo Chan Seng” in the 3rd column of item 1, the following names:

“Mr Lam Chuan Leong

BG (Retired) Tan Chin Tiong”;

(b) by deleting the name “BG (NS) Tan Chin Tiong” in the 3rd column of item 7 and substituting the name “BG (Retired) Tan Chin Tiong”; and

(c) by inserting, immediately after the name “BG (Retired) Tan Chin Tiong” in the 3rd column of item 7, the name “Mr Richard Magnus”.
