## **INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT 1976**

# INFECTIOUS DISEASES (COVID-19 — STAY ORDERS) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 73 of the Infectious Diseases Act 1976, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations are the Infectious Diseases (COVID-19 — Stay Orders) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2022 and come into operation on 26 January 2022.

#### Amendment of regulation 2

**2.** Regulation 2(1) of the Infectious Diseases (COVID-19 — Stay Orders) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 182/2020) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting the definitions of "relevant medical certificate" and "requirements of Protocol 1".

### Amendment of regulation 3

**3.** Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is amended —

- (a) by deleting paragraphs (2) and (2A); and
- (b) by deleting the words "or contravenes paragraph (2)" in paragraph (3).

#### Amendment of regulation 4

- 4. Regulation 4(5) of the principal Regulations is amended
  - (*a*) by inserting the word "or" at the end of sub-paragraph (*a*); and

(b) by deleting sub-paragraph (b).
