### PRISONS ACT 1933

#### PRISONS ACT 1933 (AMENDMENT OF FIRST AND SECOND SCHEDULES) ORDER 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 82(1) of the Prisons Act 1933, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Prisons Act 1933 (Amendment of First and Second Schedules) Order 2024 and comes into operation on 1 June 2024.

#### **Amendment of First Schedule**

2. In the Prisons Act 1933, in the First Schedule, in item 6, after paragraph (15), insert —

“(15A) Section 11F	Trafficking in psychoactive substance	one year	-
(15B) Section 11G	Manufacture of psychoactive substance	one year	-
(15C) Section 11H	Import and export of psychoactive substance	one year	-
(15D) Section 11I	Possession and consumption of psychoactive substance	one year	-
(15E) Section 11K	Possession of paraphernalia for consumption, etc., of psychoactive substance	one year	-
(15F) Section 11L	Responsibilities of owners, tenants, etc.	one year	-

(15G) Section 11M	Arranging or planning gatherings where psychoactive substances are to be consumed or trafficked	one year	-
(15H) Section 11N(1)	Exposing child to psychoactive substance, etc.	one year	-
(15I) Section 11N(2)	Permitting young person to consume psychoactive substance, etc.	one year	-
(15J) Section 11O	Introducing psychoactive substance trafficker to another person	one year	-
(15K) Section 11P(1)	Instructing person to manufacture or consume psychoactive substance, etc.	one year	-
(15L) Section 11P(2)	Disseminating or publishing information on the manufacture or consumption of psychoactive substance, etc.	one year	-
(15M) Section 11Q	Causing or procuring young person or vulnerable person to commit certain offences relating to psychoactive substances	one year	-".

### **Amendment of Second Schedule**

**3.** In the Prisons Act 1933, in the Second Schedule, in paragraph (5), replace “section 5” with “section 5, 7, 11F or 11H”.
