ORDER 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 63 of the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act (Amendment of Second Schedule) (No. 2) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 1 September 2017.

Amendment of Second Schedule

2. The Second Schedule to the Corruption, Drug Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (Confiscation of Benefits) Act is amended by inserting, immediately after the *Note* to Part XVII, the following Part:

*“Part XVIII — Offences included as serious offences with effect from
1 September 2017*

<i>Offences</i>	<i>Description</i> *
Terrorism (Suppression of Misuse of Radioactive Material) Act 2017 (Act 27 of 2017)	
444. Section 4	Possessing radioactive material or Convention device
445. Section 5	Making Convention device
446. Section 6(1)	Using radioactive material or Convention device
447. Section 7(1)	Using or damaging nuclear facility in manner that causes, or creates risk of, release of radioactive material
448. Section 8	Threatening to do act that would be offence under section 6 or 7
449. Section 9	Making demands relating to radioactive material, Convention device or nuclear facility
450. Section 10	Attempting to commit offence under section 4, 5, 6 or 7
