MEDICINES ACT 1975

MEDICINES (MEDICAL ADVERTISEMENTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 52 and 74 of the Medicines Act 1975, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Medicines (Medical Advertisements) (Amendment) Regulations 2024 and come into operation on 1 July 2024.

Replacement of Schedule

2. In the Medicines (Medical Advertisements) Regulations (Rg 2), replace the Schedule with —

FEES

1. Application fee for a permit for —	
(a) a medical advertisement using light and sound projection	\$220
(b) any other medical advertisement that is not a sales promotion	\$111
2. Application fee for a permit for a sales promotion, in addition to the fee in item 1, if any	\$111
3. Fee for a permit, for the first year, for —	
(a) a medical advertisement using light and sound projection	\$111

- 4. Fee for a permit, for the first year, of a sales \$111 promotion, in addition to the fee in item 3, if any
- 5. Fee for the renewal of a permit, for each subsequent year, for
 - (a) a medical advertisement using light and \$331 sound projection
 - (b) any other medical advertisement that is not a \$222 sales promotion
- 6. Fee for the renewal of a permit, for each \$222 subsequent year, for a sales promotion, in addition to the fee in item 5, if any
- 7. Fee for an application to amend a permit \$57
- 8. Fee for an application to transfer one or more \$18". permits to another person
