**PUBLIC ORDER
(COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Composition of Offences) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 and come into operation on 26 June 2020.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2 of the Public Order (Composition of Offences) Regulations 2016 (G.N. No. S 250/2016) is amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately after the words “Regulations 2009” in paragraph (b), the words “or the Public Order (Election Meetings and Processions in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009”; and
- (b) by inserting, immediately after the words “Regulations 2017” in paragraph (d), the words “or the Public Order (Election Meetings and Processions in Presidential Elections) Regulations 2017”.
