### **CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE**

#### **CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) NOTIFICATION 2023**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Notification:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Notification is the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) (Amendment No. 3) Notification 2023 and comes into operation on 8 July 2023.

#### **Amendment of First Schedule**

**2.** In the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 723/2020), in the First Schedule —

(a) in item 1, in the second column, replace paragraph 2 with —

“2. The following departments and subjects in the Second Schedule:

(a) International Financial Cooperation

(b) Monetary Authority of Singapore

(c) Monetary Policy, Financial Services Sector and Securities Industry

(d) Securities Industry Council

(e) Strategy Group and Whole-of-Government Strategic Planning and Policy Coordination (except the departments and subjects for which Mr Teo Chee Hean is responsible)”; and

(b) delete item 3.
