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In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 42) Notification 2017.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister exempts The Japanese Association, Singapore (called in this Notification the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Charity Draw 2017” promotion to be held from 14 September 2017 to 25 November 2017 (both dates inclusive) and the draw to be held at the premises of the organiser at 1.15 p.m. on 25 November 2017.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The price of the draw ticket, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes to be distributed, must be clearly stated on each draw ticket.
2. Each draw ticket must only be issued by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
3. The name, identity card number (if available), address, contact number and email address (if available) of the purchaser of each draw ticket must be recorded on the counterfoil of the ticket.
4. The draw must be conducted —
 - (a) by the organiser and its officers only; and
 - (b) in public.
5. The draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act —
 - (a) to be a lottery for the purposes of the Act; or
 - (b) to be a game of chance, or a mixed game of chance and skill, for the purposes of the Act.
6. The draw must not involve the use of any article declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act to be an instrument or appliance for gaming.
7. All winners must be notified in writing by ordinary post.
8. The results of the draw must be published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners.
9. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draw are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 26 February 2018.
