In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification is the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 6) Notification 2016.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Minister exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "Chinese New Year 2016 Fortune Bowl Prediction Contest" promotion and the 9 draws to be held on 9 February 2016 from 12.50 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. at the Derby Room of the Singapore Racecourse.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, where the winners are determined solely or partly by a draw, the time, date and place of the draw, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Only persons in the employment of the Singapore Turf Club may conduct a draw.
- 3. A draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 4. A draw must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 5. The prizes of the draws must be distributed on 9 February 2016 at the Derby Room of the Singapore Racecourse.
- 6. The Singapore Turf Club must, before the start of the draws, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts and the results of the draws are sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 10 May 2016.
