COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES)
(PERFORMANCES AND OTHER ACTIVITIES —
CONTROL ORDER) (AMENDMENT NO. 9)
REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Performances and Other Activities — Control Order) (Amendment No. 9) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 19 July 2021.

Amendment of regulation 10

2. Regulation 10(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Performances and Other Activities — Control Order) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 927/2020) is amended —

(a) by deleting “5” in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting in each case “2”; and

(b) by deleting sub-paragraph (c) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(c) not more than 2 performers, one of whom performs by singing and the other by playing a wind musical instrument.”
