CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) NOTIFICATION 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification is the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) (Amendment No. 4) Notification 2023 and comes into operation on 1 August 2023.

Amendment of Fourth Schedule

2. In the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 723/2020), in the Fourth Schedule, under the heading “**Subjects**”, in item 5 —

(a) after paragraph (2), insert —

“(2A) National Symbols Act 2022 and other National Symbols”; and

(b) delete paragraph (4).
