### PARKING PLACES ACT (CHAPTER 214)

#### PARKING PLACES (URBAN REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 6) ORDER 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 9 of the Parking Places Act, the Minister for Communications hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Urban Redevelopment Authority) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1998.

#### **Amendment of Schedule**

2. The following provisions of the Schedule to the Parking Places (Urban Redevelopment Authority) Order 1997 (G.N. No. S 275/97) under the heading *Parking Places* set out in the first column are amended in the manner set out in the second column thereof:

New item (44)	Insert, immediately after item (43), the following item: “(44) Neil Road.”.
PART IV	
New item (25)	Insert, immediately after item (24), the following item: “(25) The area off Hindoo Road and Kampong Kapor Road and delineated in Plan 300.”.
PART V	
New items (164) to (169)	Insert, immediately after item (163), the following items:

*First column**Second column*

- “(164) Changi North Crescent, Changi North Streets 1 and 2, Circuit Road, Upper Serangoon Road and Everitt Road North.
- (165) The area off Kinta Road and delineated in Plan 301.
- (166) The area off Old Upper Thomson Road and delineated in Plan 302.
- (167) The area off Marsiling Crescent and delineated in Plan 303.
- (168) The area off Tampines Avenue 10 and delineated in Plan 304.
- (169) The area off Geylang Road and delineated in Plan 305.”.

Insert, immediately after item (3), the following item:

- “(4) The area off Baghdad Street and delineated in Plan 306.”.
