TERRORISM
(SUPPRESSION OF FINANCING)
(GENERAL EXEMPTION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7(1) of the Terrorism (Suppression of Financing) Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Terrorism (Suppression of Financing) (General Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 28 September 2017.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Terrorism (Suppression of Financing) (General Exemption) Order 2013 (G.N. No. S 604/2013) is amended by deleting the definition of “terrorist” and substituting the following definition:

““terrorist” means any person who —

- (a) commits, or attempts to commit, any terrorist act; or
- (b) participates in or facilitates the commission of any terrorist act,

and includes a person mentioned only in paragraph 1A of the First Schedule to the Act, but excludes a person mentioned in paragraph 1, or in both paragraphs 1 and 1A, of that Schedule.”.
