INFECTIOUS DISEASES  
(DECLARATION OF ISOLATION AREA)  
(MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) (NO. 5)  
NOTIFICATION 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 17(1) of the Infectious Diseases Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Notification:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Notification is the Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 5) Notification 2020 and comes into operation on 14 July 2020.

**Amendment of Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (No. 4) Notification 2020**

2. Paragraph 2 of the Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (No. 4) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 255/2020) is amended by deleting sub-paragraphs (a), (c), (d) and (e).

3. Paragraph 2 of the Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (No. 5) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 260/2020) is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (a).

**Amendment of Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (Cochrane Lodge 1) Notification 2020**

4. Paragraph 2 of the Infectious Diseases (Declaration of Isolation Area) (Cochrane Lodge 1) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 267/2020) is amended by deleting sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (d) and (e).
