### CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE (CHAPTER 68)

### CRIMINAL PROCEDURE (AMENDMENT) RULES 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 428A(15) of the Criminal Procedure Code, the Minister for Law makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Rules 2019 and come into operation on 31 January 2019.

#### **Amendment of rule 6**

2. Rule 6 of the Criminal Procedure Rules 2018 (G.N. No. S 727/2018) is amended by deleting the words “foreign State” wherever they appear in paragraphs (1)(c) and (2) and substituting in each case the words “foreign jurisdiction”.

#### **Amendment of rule 11**

3. Rule 11 of the Criminal Procedure Rules 2018 is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “within the day on which that application is filed” in paragraph (3) and substituting the words “at the same time as the filing of that application”; and
- (b) by deleting the words “within the day on which that application is filed” in paragraph (4).

**Saving and transitional provision**

4. Despite rule 3, rule 11 of the Criminal Procedure Rules 2018 as in force immediately before 31 January 2019 continues to apply to an applicant in a leave application made under section 394H(1) of the Code before that date.
