In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (OCBC National Championships — Exemption) Order 2023.

Definitions

- 2. In this Order
 - "specified event" means the event known as the OCBC National Championships 2023, organised by the Singapore Cycling Federation, in respect of which a permit has been granted under section 143 of the Act;
 - "specified road" means any of the roads delineated by the black-coloured line in the map set out in the Schedule.


Exemption for bicycles

- **3.** Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 8, 10, 11 and 11A of the Road Traffic (Bicycles) Rules (R 3) do not apply to, or in relation to, a bicycle when it is used for the purpose of the specified event on a specified road during the periods
 - (a) from 2 a.m. to 5 p.m. on 6 August 2023; and
 - (b) from 2 a.m. to 5 p.m. on 3 September 2023.
