In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5(1) of the Protected Areas and Protected Places Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Protected Places (No. 8) Order 2018 and comes into operation on 14 September 2018.

Premises declared to be protected place

- **2.**—(1) The premises described in the second column of the Schedule are declared to be a protected place for the purposes of the Act.
- (2) A person must not enter or remain in those premises unless the person
 - (a) is in possession of a pass-card or permit issued by the authority specified in the first column of the Schedule; or
 - (b) has the permission of an authorised officer on duty at those premises to enter those premises.


