CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY) (AMENDMENT NO. 5) NOTIFICATION 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification is the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) (Amendment No. 5) Notification 2023 and is deemed to have come into operation on 1 August 2023.

Amendment of Tenth Schedule

2. In the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 723/2020), in the Tenth Schedule, under the heading “**Subjects**”, in item 5 —

(a) after paragraph (7), insert —

“(7A) Foreign National Emblems (Control of Display Act 1949”); and

(b) delete paragraph (18).
