In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 37) Notification 2011.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the Singapore Turf Club from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Scratch & Win Promotion for Hong Kong Races” event to be held from 1st October 2011 to 16th October 2011 (both dates inclusive) at the Singapore Racecourse and 17 off-course betting centres and outlets.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the Singapore Turf Club with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed and their manner of distribution shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
2. The Singapore Turf Club shall undertake to ensure that —
 - (a) all prizes which are not won or remain unclaimed more than 2 months after the announcement of the winners or their equivalent shall, unless the Minister directs otherwise, be donated to the Community Chest or such other charity as may be approved by the Minister; and
 - (b) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the lottery, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, within 3 months after the termination of the lottery.
