ARRANGEMENT OF RULES

Rule

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Compoundable offences

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 61 of the Planning Act, the Minister for National Development makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Planning (Composition of Offences) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 1 October 2018.

Compoundable offences

- **2.** The following offences may be compounded by the competent authority in accordance with section 57 of the Act:
 - (a) an offence (other than a continuing offence) under section 12(1) or (2), read with section 12(4), of the Act;
 - (b) an offence (other than a continuing offence) under section 15(3A), read with section 15(3B), of the Act;
 - (c) an offence (other than a continuing offence) under section 30(1), read with section 30(3), of the Act.
