In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 39) Notification 2011.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts World Sport Group Pte. Ltd. (referred to in this Notification as “the organiser”) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “ARC Children Centre” lucky draw promotion to be held from 10th November 2011 to 13th November 2011 (both dates inclusive), and the draw to be conducted on 13th November 2011 at Sentosa Golf Club.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The price of the lucky draw ticket, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes shall be clearly stated on the tickets.
2. No lucky draw ticket shall be issued except by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
3. The name, identity card number (if available), contact number and email address (if available) of the purchaser of every lucky draw ticket shall be recorded on the counterfoil of the ticket.
4. The lucky draw shall be conducted by the organiser and its officers only.
5. The lucky draw shall be conducted in public.
6. The lucky draw does not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
7. The lucky draw does not involve the use of any instrument or appliance of gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
8. Before the lucky draw promotion starts, the organiser must undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, within 3 months after the termination of the lucky draw.
