**ROAD TRAFFIC ACT
(CHAPTER 276)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC (COLLECTION OF TOLL AT
WOODLANDS AND TUAS CHECKPOINTS)
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 34D and 140(1) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Collection of Toll at Woodlands and Tuas Checkpoints) (Amendment) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 1 February 2018.

Amendment of rule 3

2. Rule 3 of the Road Traffic (Collection of Toll at Woodlands and Tuas Checkpoints) Rules (R 12) is amended —

- (a) by deleting sub-paragraph (*aa*) of paragraph (1); and
- (b) by deleting sub-paragraph (*aa*) of paragraph (2).

Amendment of Schedule

3. Parts I and II of the Schedule to the Road Traffic (Collection of Toll at Woodlands and Tuas Checkpoints) Rules are deleted and the following Part substituted therefor:

“PART I

Toll payable at the Woodlands Checkpoint for using the Johore Bahru —
Woodlands Causeway to leave Singapore —

<i>Description of vehicle</i>	<i>Toll payable</i>
(1) Buses	\$0.80
(2) Cars	\$1.00
(3) Heavy goods vehicles	\$2.00
(4) Taxis	\$0.50
(5) Vans or light goods vehicles having 2 axles or 6 wheels or less	\$1.50

”.
