SECURITIES AND FUTURES (EXEMPTION FOR CROSS-BORDER ARRANGEMENTS) (FOREIGN RELATED CORPORATIONS) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 337(1) of the Securities and Futures Act 2001, the Monetary Authority of Singapore makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Securities and Futures (Exemption for Cross-Border Arrangements) (Foreign Related Corporations) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2023 and come into operation on 9 October 2023.

Amendment of regulation 6

2. In the Securities and Futures (Exemption for Cross-Border Arrangements) (Foreign Related Corporations) Regulations 2021 (G.N. No. S 760/2021), in regulation 6(1)(e), replace “any customer” with “every customer”.
