(CHAPTER 339)

UNITED NATIONS (ANTI-TERRORISM MEASURES)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the United Nations Act, the Minister for Law hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and shall come into operation on 1st October 2013.

**Amendment of regulation 4**

2. Regulation 4(1) of the United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Regulations (Rg 1) (referred to in these Regulations as the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting the definition of “funds”.

**Deletion of regulations 5, 6 and 7**

3. Regulations 5, 6 and 7 of the principal Regulations are deleted.

**Amendment of regulation 9**

4. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting “5, 6, 7,”.

**Deletion and substitution of regulation 10**

5. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is deleted and the following regulation substituted therefor:

**“Duty to provide information**

10.—(1) Every person in Singapore, and every citizen of Singapore outside Singapore, who has information about any

transaction or act prohibited by regulation 7A, 7B, 7C or 8, shall —

- (a) immediately inform the Commissioner of Police or any authorised person of that information; and
- (b) provide such further information relating to the transaction or act as the Commissioner of Police or authorised person may require.

(2) In this regulation —

“authorised person” means such person as the Minister may designate for the purposes of this regulation;

“Commissioner of Police” includes —

- (a) any police officer; and
- (b) any person authorised by the Commissioner of Police to act for him for the purposes of this regulation.”.

### **Amendment of regulation 11**

**6.** Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is amended —

- (a) by deleting “5, 6, 7,”; and
- (b) by deleting the words “or 10” and substituting the words “or 10(1)”.
