**BANKING ACT
(CHAPTER 19)**

**BANKING (CREDIT CARD AND CHARGE CARD)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 78(1) and (2) of the Banking Act, the Monetary Authority of Singapore makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Banking (Credit Card and Charge Card) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2015 and come into operation on 1 November 2015.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2 of the Banking (Credit Card and Charge Card) Regulations 2013 (G.N. No. S 729/2013) is amended by deleting the definition of “medical treatment” and substituting the following definition:

““medical treatment” means any “approved medical treatment or services” as defined in section 2(1) of the MediShield Life Scheme Act 2015 (Act 4 of 2015) but excludes any treatment, service or item referred to in regulation 12(2)(a) of the MediShield Life Scheme Regulations 2015 (G.N. No. S 622/2015);”.
