In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 55) Notification 2013.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts all of the following committees (referred to in this Notification as “the organisers”) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “PA Active Agers’ Mind Game (Mahjong) Challenge & Rummy-O Interest Group Gathering 2013” promotion to be held from 10th November 2013 to 17th November 2013 (both dates inclusive) and the mahjong games to be held on 17th November 2013 from 12 noon to 5 p.m. at the multi-purpose hall of Sengkang Community Club:

- (a) People’s Association Active Ageing Council;
- (b) Punggol Central Active Ageing Committee;
- (c) Sengkang Community Club Seniors Citizens’ Executive Committee.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organisers with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The only game played shall be mahjong.
2. All players must be People's Association PAssion Card members, at least 45 years of age and residing in the Pasir Ris-Punggol Group Representation Constituency, and all spectators and staff must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Prize sponsors must not be involved in any business related to gambling.
4. Advertising for the mahjong competition shall be confined to posters and banners displayed within such area within the Pasir Ris-Punggol Group Representation Constituency as is designated by the organisers to be the Punggol Central district.
5. Token prizes can be allowed in recognition of the skills shown by the winners.
6. The organisers shall ensure that the rules of the game are explained clearly to all players before the start of the event.
7. The organisers shall deploy umpires on site to referee the event and resolve any disputes.
8. The mahjong activities shall be held indoors at the multi-purpose hall of Sengkang Community Club.
9. The multi-purpose hall of Sengkang Community Club must have adequate sound-proofing to minimise noise pollution.
10. The organisers must open up the premises for spot-checks by the police during the event.
11. The organisers must take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no private deals or side-betting throughout the event.
