In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 71) Notification 2014.

Definition

2. In this Notification, “organisers” means —
- (a) the Bukit Gombak Senior Citizens’ Executive Committee;
 - (b) the Bukit Gombak Community Sports Club;
 - (c) the Guilin Residents’ Committee;
 - (d) the Goodview Garden Residents’ Committee;
 - (e) the SunShine Residents’ Committee; and
 - (f) the Hillgrove Residents’ Committee.

Exemption

3.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the organisers from the provisions of the Act in respect of —

- (a) the “Bukit Gombak Mind Game Mahjong Challenges 2014” promotion to be held from 21 October 2014 to 2 November 2014 (both dates inclusive); and
- (b) the mahjong games to be held at the seminar room of Bukit Batok Civil Service Club House as part of that promotion from 8 a.m. to 2.30 p.m. on 2 November 2014.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organisers with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The only game played must be mahjong.
2. All players must be at least 21 years of age and residing in such area within the Chua Chu Kang Group Representation Constituency as is designated by the organisers to be the Bukit Gombak district, and all spectators and staff must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Prize sponsors must not be involved in any business related to gambling.
4. Advertising for the mahjong competition must be confined to posters and banners displayed within the Bukit Gombak district.
5. The organisers may charge an entrance fee of \$20 for PAssion Card members and \$25 for non-PAssion Card members to cover the cost of hosting the mahjong competition, less the value of the prizes.
6. Token prizes can be allowed in recognition of the skills shown by the winners.
7. The organisers must ensure that the rules of the game are explained clearly to all players before the start of the event.
8. The organisers must deploy umpires on site to referee the event and resolve any disputes.
9. The mahjong activities must be held indoors at the seminar room of Bukit Batok Civil Service Club House.

THE SCHEDULE — *continued*

10. The seminar room of Bukit Batok Civil Service Club House must have adequate sound-proofing to minimise noise pollution.
11. The organisers must open up the premises for spot-checks by the police during the event.
12. The organisers must take all reasonable steps to ensure that there are no private deals or side-betting throughout the event.
