LIQUOR CONTROL (SUPPLY AND CONSUMPTION) ACT 2015

LIQUOR CONTROL (SUPPLY AND CONSUMPTION) (EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 29(1) of the Liquor Control (Supply and Consumption) Act 2015, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Liquor Control (Supply and Consumption) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2023 and comes into operation on 2 January 2024.

New paragraph 1A

2. In the Liquor Control (Supply and Consumption) (Exemption) Order 2017 (G.N. No. S 426/2017) (called in this Order the principal Order), after paragraph 1, insert —

“Definition

1A. In this Order, “telecommunication service” has the meaning given by section 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1999.”.

Amendment of paragraph 3

3. In the principal Order, in paragraph 3(1) —
- (a) in sub-paragraph (b), replace “through an online service” with “online or through a telecommunication service”; and
 - (b) replace “through the online service” with “online or through the telecommunication service”.

Amendment of paragraph 4

4. In the principal Order, in paragraph 4(1) —
- (a) in sub-paragraph (b), replace “through an online service” with “online or through a telecommunication service”; and
 - (b) replace “through the online service” with “online or through the telecommunication service”.
