In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) of the Infrastructure Protection Act 2017, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Infrastructure Protection (Protected Places) (No. 21) Order 2023 and comes into operation on 10 November 2023.

#### **Premises declared to be protected place**

2. The premises described in the second column of the Schedule are declared to be a protected place for the purposes of the Act, and the person specified in the first column of that Schedule is designated as the authority of the protected place.


