ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (ELECTRONIC ROAD PRICING SYSTEM) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34D of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 7 November 2018.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. Part 11 of the First Schedule to the Road Traffic (Electronic Road Pricing System) Rules 2015 (G.N. No. S 226/2015) is amended by deleting Division 2 and substituting the following Division:

“Division 2

CHARGES ON WEEKDAYS

Amount of road-user charge payable on any day from Monday to Friday from 8.30 a.m. but before 9 a.m., not being a public holiday.
