COMMON GAMING HOUSES ACT (CHAPTER 49)

COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 8) NOTIFICATION 2012

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

2. Exemption The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 8) Notification 2012.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the National Service Resort & Country Club (referred to in this Notification as "the organiser") from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "NSRCC Charity Golf 2012" event to be held from 1st March 2012 to 27th May 2012 (both dates inclusive) and the draw to be held on 27th May 2012 between 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. at the premises of the organiser.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions stated in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The price of the draw tickets, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes shall be clearly stated on the tickets.
- 2. No draw ticket shall be issued except by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
- 3. The name, identity card number (if available), contact number and email address (if available) of the purchaser of every draw ticket shall be recorded on the counterfoil of the ticket.
- 4. The draw shall be conducted by the organiser and its officers only.
- 5. The draw shall be conducted in public.
- 6. The draw shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 7. The draw shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 8. The organiser shall undertake to ensure that
 - (a) all winners shall be notified in writing by ordinary post;
 - (b) the results of the draw shall be published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners; and
 - (c) an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the draw, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, within 3 months after the termination of the draw.
