COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 15) NOTIFICATION 2014

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 15) Notification 2014.

Exemption

- **2.**—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. from the provisions of the Act in respect of
 - (a) the "Rush for Gold" promotion to be held from 13th February 2014 to 11th April 2014 (both dates inclusive); and
 - (b) the kiosk games to be held at all Sands Rewards Club kiosks within the premises of the casino of Marina Bay Sands as part of the "Rush for Gold" promotion, from 6 a.m. each day between 3rd March 2014 and 10th April 2014 (both dates inclusive) to before 6 a.m. the following day.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- The methodology of the promotion, the details of the prizes to be distributed, their manner of distribution and, if the winners are determined solely or partly by a lottery, the time, date and place of the lottery, shall be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which shall be freely available to all participants.
- 2. Every lottery shall be conducted by persons in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. only.
- 3. Every lottery shall be conducted in public.
- 4. Every lottery by means of a computerised system which is not conducted in public shall be witnessed and audited by a public accountant who is not in the employment of Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd.
- 5. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 6. Every lottery shall not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 7. Marina Bay Sands Pte. Ltd. shall undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts shall, together with the results of the lotteries, be sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 12th July 2014.
