Regulation

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 102 of the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore Act, the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore, with the approval of the Minister for Transport, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Composition of Offences) (Revocation) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 15 October 2021.

Revocation

2. The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Composition of Offences) Regulations (Rg 1) are revoked.

Saving provision

3. Despite regulation 2, the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Composition of Offences) Regulations as in force immediately before 15 October 2021 continue to apply for the purposes of offences reasonably suspected to have been committed before that date under the Act or any regulations made under the Act.
