ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT
(FEES FOR LICENCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77 of the Environmental Protection and Management Act, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Environmental Protection and Management (Fees for Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and shall come into operation on 1 January 2015.

Deletion and substitution of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Environmental Protection and Management (Fees for Licences) Regulations (Rg 3) is deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:

“THE SCHEDULE

Regulation 2

FEES

<i>First column</i>	<i>Second column</i>
1. For the grant or renewal of a licence to import or sell hazardous substances	(a) \$135 for 3 months (b) \$525 for one year
2. For making amendments to a licence to import or sell hazardous substances on any one occasion	\$95”.
