COMMON GAMING HOUSES (EXEMPTION) (NO. 6) NOTIFICATION 2015

The Schedule

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 6) Notification 2015.

Exemption

- 2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts the National Service Resort & Country Club (called the organiser) from the provisions of the Act in respect of the "NSRCC Charity Golf 2015" event to be held from 17 February 2015 to 16 May 2015 (both dates inclusive) and the draw to be held on 17 May 2015 between 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. at the ballroom of the National Service Resort & Country Club at Kranji.
- (2) The exemption is subject to compliance by the organiser with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

- 1. The price of the draw ticket, the name and address of the organiser, and the details of the prizes must be clearly stated on the ticket.
- 2. No draw ticket may be issued except by way of sale and upon receipt of its price in full.
- 3. The name, identity card number (if available), contact number and email address (if available) of the purchaser of every draw ticket must be recorded on the counterfoil of the ticket.
- 4. The draw must be conducted by the organiser and its officers only.
- 5. The draw must be conducted in public.
- 6. The draw must not involve the use of any game, method, device, scheme or competition declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(3) of the Act.
- 7. The draw must not involve the use of any instrument or appliance for gaming declared by the Minister in a notification under section 2(4) of the Act.
- 8. All winners must be notified in writing by ordinary post.
- 9. The results of the draw must be published in one major daily newspaper in Singapore within 7 days after the determination of all the winners.
- 10. The organiser must, before the start of the draw, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts, together with the results of the draw, is sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 18 August 2015.
