**CONSUMER PROTECTION (FAIR TRADING)  
(OPT-OUT PRACTICES) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Consumer Protection (Fair Trading) Act, the Minister for Trade and Industry makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Consumer Protection (Fair Trading) (Opt-Out Practices) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 1 November 2021.

**Amendment of regulation 7**

2. Regulation 7(2) of the Consumer Protection (Fair Trading) (Opt-Out Practices) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 67/2009) is amended by deleting the definition of “ElderShield Scheme” and substituting the following definition:

““ElderShield Scheme” means the severe disability insurance scheme called the ElderShield Scheme established by section 11(1)(b) of the CareShield Life and Long-Term Care Act 2019, and includes the former ElderShield Scheme under that Act;”.
