REGULATION OF IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Regulation of Imports and Exports Act, the Minister for Trade and Industry makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Regulation of Imports and Exports (Amendment) Regulations 2019 and come into operation on 9 February 2019.

Amendment of Seventh Schedule

2. Part 1 of the Seventh Schedule to the Regulation of Imports and Exports Regulations (Rg 1) is amended —

(a) by deleting item 4; and

(b) by inserting, immediately after item 9, the following item:

- temporarily exported to South Sudan by the forces of a State which is taking action, in accordance with international law, solely and directly to facilitate the protection or evacuation of its nationals and those for whom it has consular responsibility in South Sudan, as notified to the committee established under paragraph 16 of resolution 2206 (2015);
- (e) arms and related matériel to or in support of the African Union Regional Task Force intended solely for regional operations to counter the Lord's Resistance Army, as notified in advance to the committee established under paragraph 16 of resolution 2206 (2015);
- (f) arms and related matériel solely in support of the implementation of the terms of the peace agreement, as approved in advance by the committee established under paragraph 16 of resolution 2206 (2015); and
- (g) any other arms and related matériel as approved in advance by the committee established under paragraph 16 of resolution 2206 (2015).
