ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT (HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77(1) of the Environmental Protection and Management Act 1999, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for Sustainability and the Environment, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Environmental Protection and Management (Hazardous Substances) (Amendment) Regulations 2025 and come into operation on 1 August 2025.

Amendment of Schedule

2. In the Environmental Protection and Management (Hazardous Substances) Regulations (Rg 4), in the Schedule, after the item “Lewisites”, insert —

“

Long-chain perfluorocarboxylic acids (LC-PFCAs) (chain lengths at least C ₉ but not exceeding C ₂₁); their salts and related compounds	0
Medium-chain chlorinated paraffins (chain lengths at least C ₁₄ but not exceeding C ₁₇)	0

”.
