ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

Regulation

- 1. Citation and commencement
- 2. Compoundable offences

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Maintenance of Religious Harmony Act 1990, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Maintenance of Religious Harmony (Compoundable Offences) Regulations 2022 and come into operation on 1 November 2022.

Compoundable offences

- **2.** Each of the following offences is prescribed as a compoundable offence that may be compounded in accordance with section 17D of the Act:
 - (a) an offence under section 17H(1), 17J(1) or (2) or 17L(1) of the Act, except a continuing offence;
 - (b) an offence under section 17H(3) or 17K(3) of the Act.
