

The centre coin features a gold-plated flower Vanda Miss Joaquim, above which is the denomination “\$10”. Both are circumscribed by the words “SINGAPORE SECOND ALMANAC COIN SERIES”.  Each of the 12 coins surrounding the centre coin depicts an animal of the design featured in the second Chinese Almanac Coin Series, together with the year of issue for that animal, both in Roman numerals and in Chinese characters. The denomination “\$2” is below each design.
