In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

##### **Citation and period in force**

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Trifactor Bike & CycleRun National Duathlon Championships — Exemption) Order 2024.

(2) This Order is in force on 24 November 2024 starting 2 a.m. and ending 11 a.m.

##### **Definitions**

2. In this Order —

“specified event” means the Trifactor Bike & CycleRun National Duathlon Championships organised by Orange Room Pte. Ltd. (UEN 200811733N) on 24 November 2024;

“specified road” means any of the roads delineated by the black-coloured lines in the map set out in the Schedule.

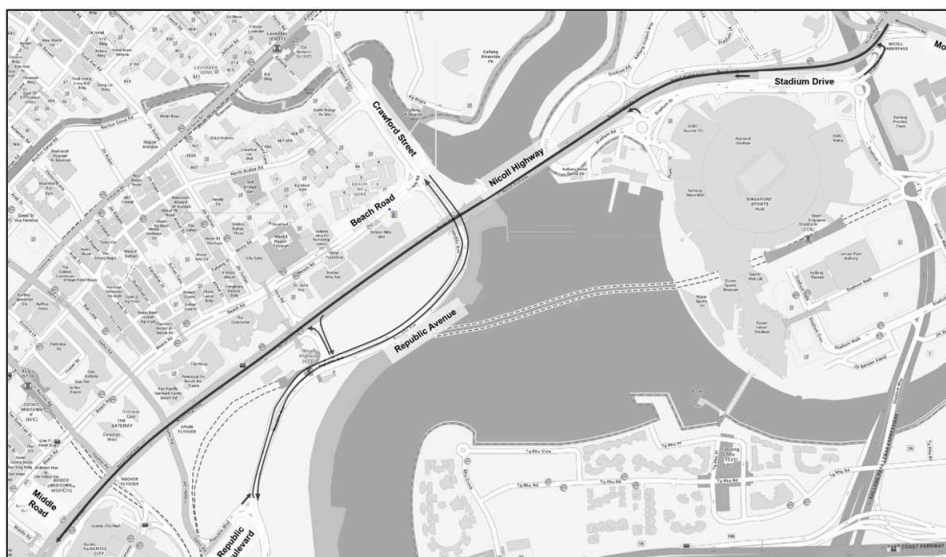
## Exemption for riding bicycle

3. Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 7B, 8, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct) Rules (R 3) do not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on a specified road during and in connection with the specified event.
