Citation and period in force

1.—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Trifactor Bike & CycleRun National Duathlon Championships — Exemption) Order 2024.

(2) This Order is in force on 24 November 2024 starting 2 a.m. and ending 11 a.m.

Definitions

- 2. In this Order
 - "specified event" means the Trifactor Bike & CycleRun National Duathlon Championships organised by Orange Room Pte. Ltd. (UEN 200811733N) on 24 November 2024;
 - "specified road" means any of the roads delineated by the black-coloured lines in the map set out in the Schedule.


Exemption for riding bicycle

3. Rules 5, 6, 7, 7A, 7B, 8, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic (Bicycles, Three-wheeled Pedal Cycles, Trishaws and Recumbent Devices — Road Conduct) Rules (R 3) do not apply to an individual who rides a bicycle on a specified road during and in connection with the specified event.
