In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24 of the Common Gaming Houses Act, the Minister for Home Affairs hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Common Gaming Houses (Exemption) (No. 8) Notification 2015.

Exemption

2.—(1) The Minister hereby exempts Burke Golf LLP from the provisions of the Act in respect of the “Putt for Charity” promotion, and the draws to be held as part of that promotion at Isetan Scotts, Level 3, Sports Department during the periods set out below:

- (a) from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily from 27 February 2015 to 1 March 2015 (both dates inclusive), with the draw for the period to be held on 1 March 2015 at or around 9 p.m.;
- (b) from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. daily from 6 March 2015 to 8 March 2015 (both dates inclusive), with the draw for the period to be held on 8 March 2015 at or around 9 p.m.

(2) The exemption is subject to compliance by Burke Golf LLP with the conditions specified in the Schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

Paragraph 2

CONDITIONS

1. The price of each putt, the name and address of Burke Golf LLP, the details of the prizes to be distributed, and the time, date and place of the draws, must be disclosed in printed publicity material, copies of which must be freely available to all participants.
2. Burke Golf LLP may only allow a participant to take part in the promotion upon receipt of the donation in full (i.e. the price of each putt).
3. The winners of each draw must be notified by telephone or in writing by electronic or other means.
4. Burke Golf LLP must, before the start of the promotion, undertake to ensure that an audited statement of accounts, together with the results of the draws, is sent by registered post to the Head, Specialised Crime Policy Branch, Criminal Investigation Department, no later than 9 June 2015.
