COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES) ACT 2020 (ACT 14 OF 2020)

COVID-19 (TEMPORARY MEASURES) (SPORTING EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES — CONTROL ORDER) (AMENDMENT NO. 12) REGULATIONS 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Sporting Events and Activities — Control Order) (Amendment No. 12) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 22 November 2021.

Amendment of regulation 3

2. Regulation 3(1) of the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Sporting Events and Activities — Control Order) Regulations 2021 (G.N. No. S 277/2021) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting "2" in sub-paragraph (a) and substituting the words "5 or fewer".

Amendment of regulation 5

3. Regulation 5(4) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting "2" in sub-paragraph (b)(i) and (ii) and substituting in each case "5".

Amendment of regulation 14

4. Regulation 14(1) of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (i) of sub-paragraph (f) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

- "(i) is seated in the spectators' area, either alone or in a cohort that consists of 5 or fewer individuals in total who are either —
 - (A) all uncleared juniors all from the same household;
 - (B) all individuals each with a cleared status; or
 - (C) a mix of uncleared juniors (all from the same household) and other individuals each with a cleared status;".
