ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (CHAUFFEURED PRIVATE HIRE CAR AND TAXI VOCATIONAL LICENCE DEMERIT POINTS SYSTEM) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 111 of the Road Traffic Act, the Land Transport Authority of Singapore makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Chauffeured Private Hire Car and Taxi Vocational Licence Demerit Points System) (Amendment) Rules 2020 and come into operation on 30 October 2020.

Amendment of First Schedule

2. The First Schedule to the Road Traffic (Chauffeured Private Hire Car and Taxi Vocational Licence Demerit Points System) Rules 2017 (G.N. No. S 365/2017) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after item 12 of Part 1, the following items:

“13. Failing to deposit property left in the vehicle in the manner required (for more than 24 hours but less than 7 days)	Rule 39(1) or (1A) PSVC	5
14. Failing to deposit property left in the vehicle in the manner required (for more than 7 days)	Rule 39(1) or (1A) PSVC	21

15. Intentionally taking booking for on-demand passenger transport service from unauthorised provider of ride-hail service	Section 11(1) Point-to-Point Passenger Transport Industry Act 2019 (Act 20 of 2019)	6
16. Taking from passenger ride-hail fare inconsistent with ride-hail fare pricing policy (by \$20 or more)	Section 23(2A)(a) read with section 23(4) PTCA	21
17. Taking from passenger ride-hail fare inconsistent with ride-hail fare pricing policy (by less than \$20)	Section 23(2A)(a) read with section 23(4) PTCA	12
18. Taking from passenger ride-hail fare more than ride-hail fare last published by the ride-hail service licensee for ride-hail service (by \$20 or more)	Section 23(2A)(b) read with section 23(4) PTCA	21
19. Taking from passenger ride-hail fare more than ride-hail fare last published by the ride-hail service licensee for ride-hail service (by less than \$20)	Section 23(2A)(b) read with section 23(4) PTCA	12”;

(b) by inserting, immediately after the acronym “PTCA” in the second column of items 1, 2, 6, 7, 13 and 14 of Part 3, the words “as in force before 30 October 2020”;

(c) by inserting, immediately after item 2 of Part 3, the following items:

“2A. Taking from taxi passenger street-hail fare inconsistent with any part of street-hail fare pricing policy for street-hail service (by \$20 or more)	Section 23(2)(a) read with section 23(4) PTCA	21
2B. Taking from taxi passenger street-hail fare more than street-hail fare last published by the street-hail service licensee for street-hail service (by \$20 or more)	Section 23(2)(b) read with section 23(4) PTCA	21”;

(d) by inserting, immediately after item 7 of Part 3, the following items:

“7A. Taking from taxi passenger street-hail fare inconsistent with any part of street-hail fare pricing policy for street-hail service (by less than \$20)	Section 23(2)(a) read with section 23(4) PTCA	12
7B. Taking from taxi passenger street-hail fare more than street-hail fare last published by the street-hail service licensee for street-hail service (by less than \$20)	Section 23(2)(b) read with section 23(4) PTCA	12”;

(e) by inserting, immediately after item 14 of Part 3, the following items:

“14A. Demanding from taxi passenger street-hail fare inconsistent with any part of street-hail fare pricing policy for street-hail service	Section 23(2)(a) read with section 23(4) PTCA	3
14B. Demanding from taxi passenger street-hail fare more than street-hail fare last published by street-hail service licensee for street-hail service	Section 23(2)(b) read with section 23(4) PTCA	3”.
