CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (MINISTERIAL RESPONSIBILITY) (AMENDMENT) NOTIFICATION 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 30 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Prime Minister makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification is the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) (Amendment) Notification 2020 and is deemed to have come into operation on 27 November 2020.

Amendment of Eleventh Schedule

2. The Eleventh Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 (G.N. No. S 723/2020) is amended by deleting the words “and 7” in item 1(8) under the heading “**Subjects**” and substituting the words “, 7, 8A, 8B and 8C”.

Amendment of Thirteenth Schedule

3. The Thirteenth Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Ministerial Responsibility) Notification 2020 is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph (7) of item 2 under the heading “**Subjects**”, the following paragraph:

“(7A) COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020 (Act 14 of 2020) (Parts 8A, 8B and 8C only)”.
